

## Assessments during Year 11

This is a summary of the controlled assessments and other coursework/portfolio work pupils will be undertaking during Year 11

Science BTEC Art and design BTEC Travel and Tourism BTEC Health and Social Care BTEC	Portfolio work will continue to take place throughout the course. All assignments MUST be completed to pass the BTEC.
CIDA	The two projects to be completed throughout the course will continue
Music Technology	Portfolio work will continue to take place throughout the course.
Project	Those pupils taking the Project will continue to work on their assignment.
Art (Fine Art) and (Textiles)	The controlled assessment that takes place over approximately 40 hours over the course will continue
Catering	All pupils will do a 2hr assessment in January/February. Not all pupils will do the assessment at the same time to ensure that they have good working conditions and this will impinge on other subject lessons. There will be two hour of formal planning before the assessment (in September) and two hours formal evaluation afterwards.
Drama	An outside performance in October will be written up in supervised sessions in the following lessons. Unit 2 assessment takes place in September of year 11. Parents should note that the exact days will depend on the availability of computer rooms. Pupils will prepare for unit 4 throughout the latter part of the course.
D & T Resistant Materials	The second assessment 20 hour assessment will continue in year 11.
English Language and English Literature	There will be controlled Assessments in September and March. In addition pupils will complete a 1.5 hour assessment as part of the Mock examination programme in November
Geography	The second assessment will take place in lessons over 6 hours at the start of the autumn term. Parents should note that the exact days will depend on the availability of computer rooms.
Music	Pupils will record their Unit 1 assessment between 19 September and 21 October in music lessons under supervision Unit 2 will be recorded under supervision in music lessons between 31 October and 2 December. Parents should note that pupils will be preparing their pieces in the lessons proceeding these times.
MFL (French, German and Spanish)	Pupils will undertake four more assessments this year. Each assessment has 1 week of preparation time and the assessment is carried out in the following 1 or 2 weeks 3 October – 14 October                      Writing 28 November – 16 December              Speaking 23 January – 10 February                    Speaking 19 March – 30 March                            Writing
PE	The 4 practical assessments during the course under a medium level of control will continue. The dates are yet to be decided
Science	Pupils will undertake two assessments (ISAs) between September and February. Each investigation will normally take five lessons.
