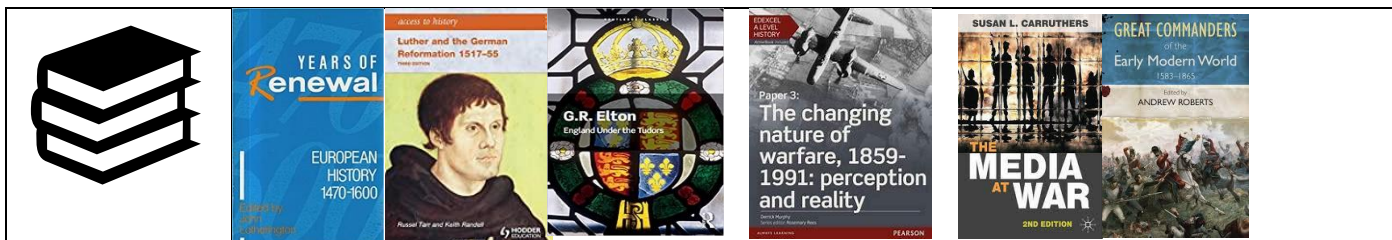


# ONCE A HISTORIAN, ALWAYS A HISTORIAN!
