

The Cams Creative Art Competition 2020 – Term & Conditions

What is The Cams Creative Art Competition?

The Cams Creative Art Competition is Cams Hill School's annual art competition open to all pupils and staff. It is a hugely popular competition which usually has over 50+ entrants every year.



How do I get involved?

If you would like to take part, you don't need to tell us, just start creating!

What do I have to create?

Each year we have a theme or starting point to help inspire you to create. This year our theme is 'Moments In Time'. You are welcome to create anything you like, it can be a pencil drawing, a painted picture, a textile piece, a 3D relief, a photographic image, a combination of them all, or something else entirely. There are separate prizes for each category, so you have a greater chance of winning. You can submit more than one piece of artwork, but you are limited to one entry per category.

What are the categories?

For every piece of artwork you submit, it should be placed into one of these categories:

<u>Fine Art</u>	This includes pencil, paint, pen and any other form of wet or dry media.
<u>Photography</u>	A printed digital or analogue image.
<u>3D/Relief</u>	Any sculptural work; clay, wire, papier-mâché, or even a relief (a piece of artwork which extends out from a flat surface).
<u>Mixed Media</u>	This is where an artwork contains many different types of media – such as a textile with paint and PVA glue / a charcoal drawing on a collaged surface / inks and pen over photographs, etc.
<u>Staff</u>	This category is for all submissions made by members of Cams Hill School staff including governors.

If you are struggling to find the best category for your artwork, email your Art Teacher.

<u>Runner Up</u>	Art Materials

I'd like to take part...but I don't have any paper or art materials...be creative, what have you got at home that you can you turn into a piece of Art?

How do I submit artwork?

This year we are asking you to submit your work photographically. To do this you will have to consider how you can do this to make your work look as good as it does in real life.

- Place your work in natural light, not direct sunlight.
- Take your photograph from above so that our image is not distorted.
- Photographic and computerised entries should be sent as jpegs or pdfs
- 3-D work should be photographed from 3 angles (front view, side view, above view)

You will need to submit your entry to the email address housechallenge@camshill.com complete with your first and last name, tutor group, house and the category your work matches best with. **Deadline 31st May 2020.**

Is there anything else I should know?

Winners and Runners Up will be informed in June and prizes will follow. Everyone who enters artwork will be recognised for their participation with house points.
