

- 2. The purpose of a portrait is to show the likeness, personality, and even the mood of the person.
- 3. For this reason, in photography, a portrait is actually not a snapshot, but an image of a person in a still position.
- 4. A portrait normally shows a person looking directly at the painter or photographer.





### Close Up's of Facial Features



### Colours, Moods, Hot and Cold.




Using watercolour paints, colouring pencils or felt tip pens (not Sharpies) colour in one side of the face with warm colours and the other with cool colours.



One of the best way to discover how an artist creates their work is too copy them. This is a challenging but very rewarding task. In pencil, draw the missing side of this face by copying what you can see.




