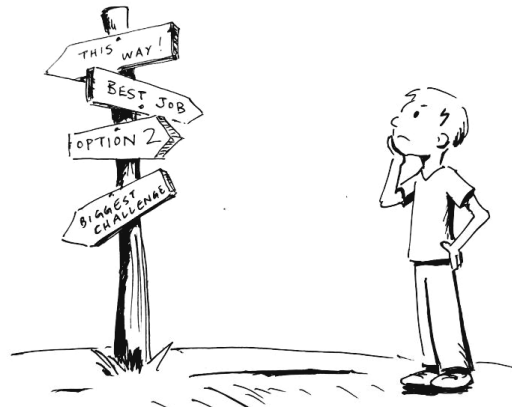

The UK's roaring creative industries made a contribution to the economy in 2017, smashing through the £100 billion mark.

Its value of the creative industries to the UK is up from £..... billion in 2016 to £..... billion, and has grown at nearly the rate of the economy since 2010. Film, TV, radio, photography, music, advertising, museums, and creative industries are all part of this thriving sector.

The increase has been driven in part by a boom in the services sub-sector which includes games such as Batman Arkham made by London-based games company, Rocksteady Studios and Red Dead Redemption 2 produced by Scottish company, Rockstar Games. This sector alone is worth £..... billion.
