# What have we studied? We have completed the GCSE specification in November. At this point, Year 11 had just completed their final unit on Vietnam. Since then, we have been consolidating knowledge on the Medicine and Germany units.

#### Here are some focus questions for revision:

### Questions you could ask at home about Vietnam.

- What tactics did USA and Vietcong use? How did this lead to USA withdrawing?
- What protest movements were there? How did this lead to USA withdrawing?
- What is Vietnamisation? How did this lead to the end of the war?

# Questions you could ask at home about Medicine.

- How did understand of disease develop?
- What factors helped improve treatments of disease from the Medieval period to Modern day? (consider: war, the role of the individual, science & technology, communication, luck/ chance, the government)
- Why was the NHS founded? What is the importance of the NHS at the time and now?

# Question you could ask at home about Germany:

- What was the Kaiser's regime like?
- What opposition was there to his monarchy and why?
- Describe life for men, women, children and Jews, during the Nazi regime.
- How did life change during WW2? What impacts were there?
- Why did support for the Nazis increase before 1933? How did
- the Great depression play a role in this?
