• A **portrait** is a painting or a photograph of a person's face and its expression.

WEEPINGWOMAN NOWOMANNOCRY MOTHERANDCHILD TECHNIQUES


- The purpose of a portrait is to show the likeness, personality, and even the mood of the person.
- For this reason, in photography, a portrait is actually not a snapshot, but an image of a person in a still position.
- A portrait normally shows a person looking directly at the painter or photographer.

Try to exactly copy the different tones to help them look 3 dimensional.







If you can't take/print your own photographs please find images online to use. If you are struggling to draw the features try looking on YouTube for step by step guides. The key is in the tonal shading!




