



COVID-19 VACCINATION UPDATE

The School Age Immunisation teams are booked to attend all Hampshire schools over the next 8 weeks (January-March) to deliver the COVID 19 vaccination to pupils aged 12-15.

Those pupils who are now aged 16 and in year 11, are also able to receive the vaccination in school.

Two doses of the COVID 19 vaccination are now recommended for full protection.

Most children are able to receive their second dose <u>12 weeks</u> after the first vaccination.

Children who have had a COVID positive test result will be required to wait 12 weeks from the date of the positive test result.

We will be offering the 1st vaccination (dose 1) to those who <u>did not</u> receive the vaccine in the Autumn Term, this includes those who have turned 12 years of age since dose 1 vaccinations were offered.

If your child misses their vaccine in school they can attend a vaccination hub, which is booked through the <u>National Booking System</u>.

If you have submitted a consent form for your child to receive the vaccine in school and you subsequently attend a vaccination centre, please can you inform your child's school with a request this is shared with the immunisation service.
