

The Cams Creative Art Competition 2022 - Term and Conditions

What is The Cams Creative Art Competition?

The Cams Creative Art Competition is Cams Hill School's annual art competition open to all pupils and staff. It is a hugely popular competition which usually has over 50+ entrants every year.

How do I get involved?

If you'd like to take part, simply come down to the Art Department (room: Art2) and ask for an Entry Form. From the opening to closing date, you will have 3 weeks to come up with, make and submit your artwork. The last date of submission is **MONDAY 7TH NOVEMBER 2022** – we cannot accept any further entries after this date.

What do I have to create?

Each year we have a theme or project to help inspire you to create. This year our theme is Coat Of Arms. You are welcome to create in any way you like, it can be a pencil drawing, a painted design, a textile piece, a 3D relief, a photographic composite, a combination of them all, or something else entirely. You will need to complete a form when you submit your work which will include five categories. Simply select the category your work matches best with. There are prizes for each category, so you have a greater chance of winning. You can submit more than one piece of artwork, but you are limited to one entry per category.

What are the categories?

For every piece of artwork you submit, it should be placed into one of these categories:

<u>Fine Art</u>	This includes pencil, paint, pen and any other form of wet or dry media.
<u>Photography</u>	A printed digital or analogue image. Unfortunately, we can't accept images on a memory stick or sent digitally. Make sure your work is printed when you submit it – if you need help with this see Ms Hutchings (the Art and Photography Technician) for help.
<u>3D/Relief</u>	Any sculptural work: clay, wire, papier-mâché, or even a relief (a piece of artwork which extends out from a flat surface).
<u>Mixed Media</u>	This is where an artwork contains many different types of media - such as a textile with paint and PVA glue / a charcoal drawing on a collaged surface / inks and pen over photographs, etc.
<u>Staff</u>	This category is for all submissions made by members of Cams Hill School staff.

If you are struggling to find the best category your artwork falls into, ask your Art Teacher for help.

How do I submit artwork?

Come along to the Art Dept. before morning tutor time, during break or lunch time or after school with your artwork AND your Entry Form. Hand your work to a member of Art Dept. staff, making sure your Entry Form is attached to your artwork (paperclip/masking taped to the back) and you have clearly written your first and last name on your artwork (preferably on the back). If you do not complete these, you may be disqualified – as we cannot identify whose work it is!

Is there anything else I should know?

Winners and Runners Up will be informed during tutor time in October (dates TBC) and prizes given out during this time too. Everyone who enters artwork will be recognised for their participation... Dependant on entry numbers, we hope to have the work exhibited around the school after the winners have been announced. If, instead, you would like your artwork back, just ask your Art Teacher.

Along with entering The Cams Creative Art Competition, we would also like to submit your work to the Hampshire CAMHS, *Coat Of Arms Project (COAP)*, which will enable you to be in with a chance of winning more prizes. Should you wish for your artwork to not be entered, just check the "Do not submit my work to HampshireCAMHS COAP" on your Entry Form. (Visit tinyurl.com/4mcmabh for more information).
