# What you need to do:

---



The competition ask is simple: look into the 350+ careers in the NHS, choose one that interests you. You can enter as an individual or up to a team of 4



Research key facts, skills, responsibilities and qualifications needed for your chosen job



Create a fun, creative and unique advertisement to tell other young people about the role. It should show the research you have completed and explain any skills, experience or qualifications the role requires.



The winning entry will be displayed in public for your local community to see, and featured in our online gallery.

# What you could win!

- House Points
- Prizes: Overall national winner(s) will have their job advertisement displayed publicly for their local community to see. They will also each receive Amazon vouchers worth £50, an NHS goody bag and a framed certificate. Overall national winner(s) will also receive a class prize which will be discussed with the winning school.
- Regional winners will each receive an Amazon voucher worth £25, an NHS goody bag and a certificate.
- Highly commended certificates will be awarded to the top entries per region.
- A certificate for best entry will be awarded to every other school that enters.
- Winners and highly commended entrants will have their entries showcased in an online gallery.
- Whether they enter individually or as a group, each student will receive a prize if their entry is chosen.

# Judging Criteria

- **30%: Student appeal**
  - Fun, lively and appealing to peer group. Was the idea/solution showcased effectively? Does it have clear structure and presentation?
- **30%: Creativity**
  - Are there any creative ideas shown? Is there anything particularly innovative in its execution? Have the student(s) created something different?
- **40%: Understanding of chosen role**
  - Understanding of role in job advertisement and what it involves such as duties and tasks.  
Understanding of entry routes to chosen career including qualifications and skills needed.
