THERE ARE FOUR TYPES OF APPRENTICESHIP:

INTERMEDIATE (LEVEL 2)

Provide basic knowledge and skills for specific jobs and are equal to GCSEs.

Entry Requirements vary

ADVANCED (LEVEL 3)

Offer more specialised knowledge and skills and are equal to A levels.

Entry requirements usually 5 GCSE's at Grade 4 or above including English and Maths (some will require grade 5)

HIGHER (LEVEL 4 TO 7)

Focus on higher-level professional skills and can be equal to a foundation degree, a Higher National Certificate (HNC), or a Higher National Diploma (HND).

Entry requirements Level 3 Apprenticeship, A-Levels or Equivalent

DEGREE (LEVEL 6 TO 7)

Continue to focus on professional skills and lead to either a full bachelor's or master's degree.

Some require certain qualifications or professional experience
