## What do these figures show?

Great to see the hours Year 11 have put in during their half-term break ahead of the in-class assessments on Monday and Tuesday.

A staggering increase in "last minute" revision happening on Sunday, the day before the first exam!

This is a 65% increase on the time spend revising on Sunday and a 76% increase of practice questions attempted. It is encouraging to see the figures since Monday, as pupils are managing a day at school as well as some revision in the evenings.

Pupils have been issued with a edited revision list, to guide them with which topics to revise - this is a strategy that will be used for the final papers too, as the topics covered in paper 1 are less likely to be tested again. We will provide a further edited revision list after the Calculator paper 2 on Monday 26 February. This should make their final preparations for the last calculator paper on Friday 1 March even easier.

So, if these support measures are used effectively, we should see this in the MathsWatch data shared with you next week.
