

Intended Destination collection

The collection of all Year 11s 'Intended Destinations' has been a historical requirement on the Local Authority and relates to schools' effectiveness in supporting their young people to enter a sustained post-16 destination.

As in previous years, the Local Authority will continue to gather 'Intended Destination' information from schools through a pre-populated 'Intended Destinations Spreadsheet'. In line with our statutory responsibility to track, monitor and support young people, we will be asking schools to provide a mobile telephone number and/or personal email address so that Hampshire Futures can contact the young person once they have left school.

This arrangement remains the same as last year and continues to align with the DfE Destinations Good Practice Guide (page 11 – paragraph 33) - [Careers guidance and access for education and training providers](#). This guidance provides a clear basis for the collection of this information as it falls under the Local Authority's statutory duties and does not require consent. As a result, Hampshire Futures will continue not to provide paper copies of consent forms. We trust this ongoing approach helps reduce unnecessary administration for your school.

This process is supported by the UK General Data Protection Regulation which details that personal data must be relevant, necessary and proportionate to the task being undertaken. It is also necessary to process personal data under a valid lawful basis. The applicable lawful basis in this instance is *public task* where processing the requested data is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller. This public task is supported by Education Act 2008 (sections 10,12, 68) which outlines our statutory duties to track children in post-16 Education.
